In times when it's easy to feel overwhelmed, we turn to our community to discover remedies for now. Here at Tracks, we believe in a collective vision and in the deep understanding our community has of itself, along with the dreams and aspirations of our passionate locals. We have created a suite of offerings, each deeply informed by this community.

The ingredients for our antidote come from a diverse range of locals, through four connected events:

1. Dance It - A public and free dance performance celebrating our open-air lifestyles, our amazing Larrakia culture, and everyone committed to building our incredible community.
2. Listen Deep - An evening of sound and music that starts with a soundtrack and then delves deeper into our sonic connections.
3. Tell Stories - An evening of stories shared in captivating ways. We all have a story, and together they form our living culture.
4. A manifesto of antidotes drawn from our workshops, dancers, audiences, and wider community members. Over 300 Antidotes were gathered by our Hope Collectors. Manifesto to be released soon.
